

GROUNDCOVER

Most groundcover are sold in 2 1/2" pots.
Groundcover should be ordered based on 32 per flat.
Items listed in quart size may be ordered individually.

Aegopodium podagrataea variegatus

Snow-on-the-Mountain

(8-10" tall) green and white leaves; wonderful for large areas, spreads quickly and freely; best in partial sun or lightly shaded areas

Ajuga reptans 'Gaiety'

Gaiety Ajuga

(8" tall) also known as Bugle Weed; bronze leaves; blue flower spikes in April through May; use in partial shade

Convallaris majalis

Lily-of-the-Valley

(8-10" tall) wide dark green leaves; wonderfully fragrant white bell-like blooms in April or May; full to part shade; sold in quarts only

Euonymus fortunei var. 'Coloratus'

Purpleleaf Wintercreeper

(12-18" tall) green leaves turning to brilliant fall colors; use in full sun to full shade

Hedera helix

Thorndale Ivy

(6" tall) long, vining stems cover quickly and effectively; dark green leaves; use in full to part shade

Pachysandra terminalis

Japanese Spurge

(9" tall) bright green leaves in circular pattern; white flowers in May; use in full to part shade

Polygonum Reynoutria

Dwarf Fleece Flower

(12-24" tall) mottled foliage; pink flowers August through September; use in full sun

Sedum 'Bailey's Gold'

Bailey's Gold Sedum

(6" tall) yellow flowers in spring through summer; green leaves turn red in winter; full sun

Sedum kamtschaticum

Kamtschaticum Sedum

(6-10" tall) yellow flowers in May; best in full sun; allow to trail in rock gardens; dry soil

Sedum spurium

Dragon's Blood Sedum

(6" tall) red flowers June through July are very showy; red tinted foliage; use in full sun and dry soil

Vinca minor 'Bowles'

Periwinkle

(6-10" tall) blue flowers in spring on vine-like stems holding small dark green leaves; use in part to full shade

Waldstenia ternata

Barren Strawberry

(6-8" tall) small yellow flowers May to June on fine foliage that closely resembles the strawberry plant; use in part to full shade
