

# ORNAMENTAL TREES

## ACER

*A. campestre*

### Hedge Maple

(35 x 35') rounded form; star-shaped glossy green foliage that turns yellow in fall; attractive corky bark; low maintenance

*A. palmatum* 'Bloodgood'

### Bloodgood Jap. Maple

(15-20') rounded habit; slow growing; red-purple foliage turning a brighter red-purple in fall; sun to part shade; protected area recommended; should be kept out of windy areas

*A. palmatum*

### Crimson Prince Maple

(20' x 22') upright, arching form; stays deep red throughout the summer; hardiest of red-leaf selections

*A. palmatum dissectum*

### Laceleaf Jap. Maple

'Crimson Queen'

(8-10' x 12') cascading, mounding habit; bright red new growth; scarlet fall color; one of the best laceleaf varieties 'Tamukeyama'

(8' x 12') width equal to height; crimson-red new foliage matures to purple-red; maintains color throughout hot summers; best purple varieties

## AMELANCHIER

*A. x grandiflora*

### Autumn Brilliance

#### Serviceberry

(20-25' x 20') rounded form; white spring flowers with green foliage; fall color is brilliant reddish-orange; red fruit is edible; light grey bark is very attractive through winter; fast growing  
Tree form is also available

*A. x grandiflora*

### Princess Diana

#### Serviceberry

(25' x 15-20') rounded, spreading habit; white spring flowers; green leaves changing to a wonderful red in the fall; purple edible fruit; fast growing

*A. canadensis*

### Shadblow Serviceberry

(20-25' x 15-20') upright branching habit; white spring flowers; green foliage spring through summer turning to yellow, gold and orange hues in fall; reddish-purple fruit is sweet and tasty, very attractive to birds

## BETULA

*B. nigra*

### Fox Valley Birch

(10' x 12') oval, rounded form; medium green foliage turning to yellow in the fall; light brown exfoliating bark

*B. x 'Royal Frost'*

### Royal Frost Birch

(35-40' x 15-20') burgundy colored leaves from spring through summer; foliage turns yellow-orange to red in fall; has exfoliation cinnamon to creamy tan bark; makes a wonderful specimen for any landscape

## CERCIS

*C. canadensis*

### Eastern Redbud

(20-30' x 25-35') multi-stemmed or low branched tree with a rounded crown; rosy pink/purple flowers open before foliage appears; lasts 2-3 weeks; new growth is reddish purple turning to green in summer; fall color is yellow-green to a nice yellow

## CORNUS

*C. alternifolia*

### Pagoda Dogwood

(15-25' x 20-35') spreading, horizontal habit; medium to dark green foliage changing to reddish purple in fall; fragrant creamy white flowers in spring

*C. mas*

### Corneliancherry

#### Dogwood

(20-25' x 15-20') oval-rounded shape; multi-stemmed shrub can be limbed up to shape into a small tree; glossy, dark green foliage through summer; fall color varies from green to purple-red

## CRATAEGUS

*C. crusgalli inermis*

### Thornless Cockspur

#### Hawthorn

(20-30' x 20-35') broad-rounded habit; an abundance of white spring flowers; green foliage in spring and summer changing to orange-rust in the fall; tiny, red fruit in fall;

*C. phaenopyrum*

### Washington Hawthorn

(25-30' x 20-25') oval to rounded shape with thorny branches; white flowers in early June; green leaves change to orange to scarlet in fall; bright red fruit in September persisting through winter;

*C. viridis*

### Winterking Hawthorn

(20' x 25') vase-shaped becoming rounded; dark green turning to yellow in fall; white flowers in spring; small red fruit; silver-grey bark & fewer thorns than Washington

## HIBISCUS

*H. syriacus*

### Rose-of-Sharon

(10-12') tree form; upright branching; green foliage changing to a poor yellow in fall; 2-4" perfectly formed flowers during July and August; available in pink, purple, red and white

## HYDRANGEA

*H. paniculata* 'Limelight'

### Limelight Hydrangea

(15') bright lime-green flowers; fade to white then tinged pink in fall; beautiful specimen patio tree

*H. paniculata* 'Grandiflora'

### PeeGee Hydrangea

(15') spreading branches full of white blooms in early August, turning to pink in fall; good for fresh or dried flowers

*H. paniculata*

### Pink Diamond Hydrangea

(15') spreading branches full of white blooms in August; change to pink 2 weeks before most other varieties

*H. paniculata* 'Bulk'

### Quick Fire Hydrangea

(15') white blooms in late May to early June; turns deep pink earlier than other varieties; flowers on new & old wood



## MAGNOLIA

*M. x loebneri*

### Leonard Messel Magnolia

(15-20') broad to broad-rounded habit; showy flowers flushed purple-pink along centers; very fragrant; no appreciable fall color

*M. x loebneri*

### Merrill Magnolia

(25-30') slightly larger in width; very large, white fragrant flowers makes a wonderful show; green foliage; fast growing

*M. soulangiana*

### Saucer Magnolia

(20-30') spread is equal to height; green summer foliage turning to a yellow-brown in fall; white to pink to purple spring flowers  
Tree form is also available

*M. stellata*

### Royal Star Magnolia

(10-15') white flowers before leaves emerge in early spring; glossy dark green foliage; width at maturity 10-15'; slow growing; easily maintained

*M. stellata*

### Pink Star Magnolia

(10-15') pink flowers before leaves emerge in spring; showy and numerous petals; glossy dark green foliage, fall color nondescript

## PHYSOCARPUS

*P. opulifolius* 'Monlo'  
pp11,211

### Diablo Ninebark

(8-10') reddish-purple foliage on arching branches; white flowers in June; withstands alkaline and dry soils; best in full sun

## PRUNUS

*P. cerasifera*

### Newport Plum

(15-30' x 15-25') rounded form; light bronze-purple new growth maturing to dark purple; pale pink to white flowers; 1" purple fruit; foliage maintains the same color throughout the season

## PRUNUS continued

*P. subhirtella pendula*

### Snow Fountain

### Weeping Cherry

(12' x 15') graceful cascading form with good green foliage; covered with white flowers in spring; beautiful form and flowers; no significant fall color

*P. virginiana* 'Shubert'

### Canada Red

### Chokecherry

(20-30' x 18-25') pyramidal habit; leaves emerge green and mature to purple; reddish purple fall color; small clusters of white flowers in spring

## PYRUS

*P. calleryana*

### Aristocrat Pear

(40-45' x 20-25') pyramidal form, open and informal; brilliant red-purple color in fall; white spring flowers

### Autumn Blaze Pear

(35-40' x 25-30') somewhat horizontal open habit; brilliant red fall color; white spring flowers

### Cleveland Select Pear

(35-40' x 15-20') columnar and dense; very formal in appearance; great red-purple fall color; abundance of white flowers in spring

### New Bradford Pear

(35' x 30') broad rounded form; orange to purplish red foliage in fall; white flowers in spring; better branching habit than the original Bradford Pear

## SALIX

*S. alba* 'Tristis'

### Golden Weeping Willow

(50-70') gracefully weeping; light green foliage with beautiful white flowers in spring; good choice for wet areas; very fast growing



*S. integra* 'H. Nishiki'

### Hakura Nishiki Willow

(5-6') rounded, spreading; pink stems and buds open to dappled green, pink & white foliage; best in partial shade

## SYRINGA

*S. pekinensis*

### Summer Charm Lilac

(15-20') upright arching, loose habit; abundant creamy white flowers in spring; finely textured, dark green leaves; looser and more open than the Ivory Silk Lilac

*S. reticulata*

### Ivory Silk Lilac

(20-25') compact, rounded form; deep dark green leaves; large panicles of white flowers are outstanding and very plentiful; available in tree form and clump form

*S. meyeri*

### Dwarf Korean Lilac

Grafted onto a 3-4' standard; will get 4-7' tall by 4-6' wide; pale violet flowers and green foliage

*S. patula*

### Miss Kim Lilac

Grafted onto a 3-3.5' standard; will get 5-7' tall by 5-6' wide; fragrant lilac flowers in spring with green foliage
